2026 RIDGE VIEW BANK SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION

Eligibility

High School seniors with intentions to further their education at a college or university with a business-related degree are eligible to apply. Student must attend a high school in the Ridge View Bank market area (City of Salem, City of Roanoke, Roanoke County, Franklin County, or Montgomery County). Dependents of Ridge View Bank Directors or Officers of are not eligible to apply.

Essay Theme

Discuss a business leader you admire and explain how their leadership style inspires your own vision of success and career aspirations.

Essay Requirements

- A minimum of 250 words
- Typed and double-spaced
- Participant name and/or family names should not appear on the essay
- Original, student-written essay without the assistance of AI

Submission Requirements

Each applicant should provide:

- A completed application including a summary of participation in community and school activities.
- One letter of academic recommendation from a present or past educator, and
- One letter of personal recommendation from a non-family member. References may not be bank employees.
- Originally written essay without the assistance of ChatBot/AI technology.
